

Guiding Principles for HHWA

1. All are welcome and treated equally regardless of race, sex, age, religion, nationality, ethnicity, sexual orientation/identity, disability, or other protected categories.
2. Information shared in confidence should be maintained as confidential.
3. Members and practitioners are to treat all others with respect and dignity. Offensive, harassing, or abusive behaviors such as bullying and emotional blackmail are not acceptable.
4. Opinions and ideas of all members are valued and can be shared at meetings or via email with all elected board members.
5. Actions on behalf of HHWA, should bring trust and credibility to the organization.
6. Each member is afforded the opportunity to reach his or her fullest potential in pursuit of the HHWA mission. HHWA members are encouraged to utilize their talents to assist HHWA.
7. All applicable federal, state, and local rules, laws, and regulations should be adhered to in a transparent manner. HHWA guidelines and mission statement should also be transparent and public.
8. Members will be open about any possible conflicts of interest.
